Dear Grade 2 Families,

Attached are instructions for home learning the week of May 10th-14th. You will find a choice board for language arts and math, and additional science and social studies activities.

Our packet includes many different activities but please know that the expectation is that students complete **5 hours of work a week**. It is up to your family to decide how you would like to break up the time to complete the activities. We wanted to provide some flexibility and choice, but we would like to suggest that the priority is reading, writing and math. **If your child reads 21 minutes or more a day, don't forget to record it on your child's 21-for-21 reading challenge sheet.** As you complete the assignments, please have your child post a photo or video of their work to SeeSaw. This way we can provide feedback and monitor progress throughout the week. If you do not have access to technology, please **save ALL your child's work and have your child bring it to school on Tuesday, May 25th.**

There will also be a class Google Meet for 45 minutes at 1:00pm **Monday through Thursday** (not Friday). The same link will be used each day. Please let us know if there is an alternate email address we should send it to (ie. babysitter, or older sibling). Outside of this class Google Meet, students can also arrange an individual Meet if they have questions or need support in completing assignments.

Even though we have set expectations for the week, we are understanding towards various family circumstances. We are flexible and want your child to do the workload that best meets your family needs. We are available to provide one-on-one support and are here to guide you through this difficult time.

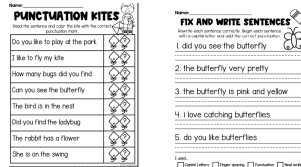
